ANNUAL CONFERENCE MEMBERS! Please give this info and application to a great high school youth in your congregation. Help us get the word out about this opportunity.

Pages are youth who are friendly, reliable, and excited about serving others. Pages are a vital (and hard-working) part of the Annual Conference sessions, helping to get information to members exactly when it's needed. Pages will get to see how Annual Conference works, and worship, learn, and play with youth from all over Oregon and Idaho.

PAGE FAQs

SO WHAT DOES A PAGE DO? You will be in on the action at Annual Conference (AC) distributing materials, running errands, carrying messages, and helping AC members with official business. Only five - six youth will be accepted as pages.

WHAT ARE THE EXPECTATIONS? Bring a great attitude. **Come to BOTH the Annual Conference Training, and Page training meeting Wednesday, June 10 to learn your job. Be at Annual Conference for all the days, Thursday through the end of Saturday, June 13.** We will help clean up the Ballroom following the closing session on Saturday. The closing worship for Annual Conference will be Saturday night. If you have a ride with an adult at Annual Conference, that adult must be willing to wait for you.

DO I GET PAID? You are responsible for your expenses while at Annual Conference (transportation, room and board). Often, home churches help out pages financially. Just ask your pastor or lay leader. An offering will be taken at Annual Conference for the pages. You will receive a check from the offering to help offset your costs after conference is over.

IS IT ANY FUN? Sure! You'll work hard during the sessions, but there's time in the evenings to meet with other youth at AC and join in some fun activities.

WHERE DO I SLEEP? This year, housing for youth will be at the Grand Hotel. There will be adult chaperones to supervise you, led by our Annual Conference youth coordinator, Anna Eckelbarger Salas. More information regarding housing will be sent to you if your application is accepted.

WHO CAN BE A PAGE? You must be in 9-12th grade right now and be active in a United Methodist Church. If there are more applications than there are openings preference will be given to those youth who have not already served as a page for at least two years.

HOW DO I APPLY? Complete the Page Application and return it to the address below by May 4, 2015. You will hear from the Floor Manager by May 10. If you are accepted, you will receive more information soon afterwards.
