51 **What will this action accomplish?**

52 This action will make it clear that the Oregon-Idaho plans to continue to practice full inclusion in
53 all areas of our church including our church leadership.

55 **Why is it important?**

56 It is important to show that we are joined with other conferences in rejecting the Traditional Plan
57 as the official position of the United Methodist Church.

59 **How will it be carried out? By whom?**

60 Each church in the conference will need to discern what this means in their context with an
61 understanding that all people are people of worth and deserve our care and respect.

63 **How much will it cost? Where will the money come from?**

64 The Bishop and the conference cabinet will need to determine how to best support this position
65 within the conference and the districts will support their churches in the same effort. There may
66 be some costs with holding events or meetings but it can not be determined at this time.
