

**Cascadia District
Church Extension Society
Grants Awarded 2019-2020**

Storydwelling, Bend (\$5,000) – Provide a musician in residence to compose new hymns for use in community worship.

Sherwood UMC (\$7,500) – Salary support for project manager who will pursue planning and permitting for a new structure on the church grounds to be used for storing and packaging food for distribution.

Open Door Churches of Salem/Keizer (\$4,500) – Support housing for summer interns

Hillsboro UMC (\$20,750 + \$41,500) – Provide support for pastoral compensation for Hispanic Ministries.

Open Door Churches of Salem/Keizer (\$20,000 + \$19,000) – Provide support for pastoral compensation for Hispanic Ministries.

Alaska Conference (\$20,000) – Supporting the Greater Northwest Episcopal Area as Alaska transitions from a missionary conference to a district within the Pacific Northwest Annual Conference.

Cascadia District churches (\$24,000) – Provide \$500 grants to every church in the district to purchase gift cards to assist people impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Suttle Lake United Methodist Camp (\$2,600) – Support housing for medically vulnerable women during COVID-19 pandemic.

Forest Grove UMC (\$2,000) – Portion of cost to install movable partition to increase number of spaces available for Family Promise shelter guests.

Nehalem Bay UMC (\$10,000) – Support startup costs for senior meal program for coastal residents (previously meals were transported from Salem).

Storydwelling, Bend (\$12,500) – Support startup costs for ReVillage co-operative preschool and co-working space.

Hillsboro UMC (\$4,000) – Support portion of cost of Camp Common Good for children of the community.

Madras UMC (\$13,000) – Portion of costs to refurbish kitchen so that it continues to qualify to support disaster relief operations.
