Openness	Open-minded, being receptive of new ideas, methods or changes.	The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.	Proverbs 9:10
Generosity	Willingly to give, help and support with one’s time, talent and treasures such as money.	Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share.	1 Timothy 6:18
